

DAILY DIGEST READINGS TO IMPROVE BUSINESS

FINCEN'S NEW REPORTING REQUIREMENT: WHAT DOES IT MEAN FOR YOU?

There's a new mandate where businesses have to report their beneficial owner to the federal government this year. This mandate is coming from the Financial Crimes Enforcement Network, or FinCEN, which is part of the Treasury Department. The new rule is impacting most businesses in the United States and includes corporations, S corporations, partnerships, etc. FinCEN wants to identify any potential bad actors that are owning businesses. This policy began on January 1st of 2024 and reporting is due by the end of the year on December 31st.
